



When you have completed your entry form and returned it to us, you will receive your information pack. Inside you will find your sponsorship form. We're asking you to try to raise as much as you can for Feed The Children by asking everyone you know at home (in your family) - mums and dads, aunts, uncles, nannies and granddads, friends and neighbours, to sponsor your walk. Don't forget to ask people at school! This is what your sponsor money can do:

- £10 Can help us give special medicines to children to stop them from having worms in their tummy.
- £12 Can help us plant 12 trees in Africa for fruit and fuel
- £15 Buys 400 bricks and building materials to build a special toilet called a latrine.
- £20 Can feed a family of four in Africa for a month.
- £25 Can buy a piglet to help start a herd of animals for the whole community and provide meat for the village.
- £40 Why not buy a kid (goat) and help a whole village have milk, meat and manure to grow plants.
- £70 Buys a sewing machine to help girls have training in sewing and making clothes for their family and village helping them to earn a living.
- £100 Buys 100 little chicks - they will grow into chickens to provide eggs and meat, providing a living for families who can take the eggs and meat to market.

We'd like to raise £10,000 for Feed the Children's projects across the world because that means we can give help to lots of children. If you raise just £30 each in sponsorship each we could do it.

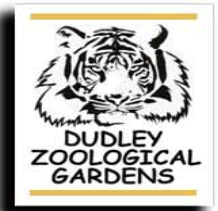
## Raising Your Sponsorship

If you have no fundraising experience, don't worry. Try these suggestions, or think of some of your own.

- Always start your form with your best sponsors. This sets the trend. A £5 or £10 donation is a good prompt for following donors.
- Don't forget your donations can be increased simply by asking people if they will gift aid their donations. We can claim an extra 28p from the taxman for every single £1 donated by a UK taxpayer.
- Take your sponsorship form everywhere you go, to school, ask your mum and dad to take it to work and ask everyone. Most people know how important the work of Feed the Children is and they'll be happy to sponsor you.
- Set yourself a target, Tell everyone how much you want to raise (don't stop at the minimum) the more you raise the more people we can help.
- Collect your pledges right away. Most people will give you a donation and it will save you waiting for sponsorship pledges.
- Hold a fundraising activity at school, Hold a raffle. Use our A-Z of ideas to get you started. Hold a car wash
- Be HAPPY about your challenge!! SHOUT ABOUT IT!!
- Get your photo taken and get your challenge in print!! If you're enthusiastic about what you're doing, everyone else will be too.
- Most important of all: HAVE A GREAT TIME WHILE YOU ARE FUNDRAISING.
